Conditions

1. The tournament will be decided by 36 holes stroke play qualifying from which the leading 16 scratch scores and thereafter the leading 48 nett scores will contest knockout match play.
2. Ties in the qualifying competition will be decided by the best last 18 holes. If the competitors are still tied the winner will be decided by the best last nine holes, then last six holes, last three holes and finally the last hole. If competitors are still tied the result will be decided by lot.
3. Matches finishing all square will continue from the 1st hole until one side wins a hole. In the handicap sections shots will be allowed as in the prescribed round.
4. Prizes will be awarded as follows:-

Clynelish Salver - Winner £250 + bottle of Brora whisky or equivalent

Handicap Sections - Winner £180 + bottle of Clynelish whisky

Runners up and losing semi finalists will receive vouchers to a value no less than £80. All losing quarter finalist will receive a bottle of Clynelish whisky.

The player returning the lowest aggregate scratch score in the qualifying rounds will receive the W. J. Henderson medal.

Prizes will be awarded for the best scratch score in both qualifying rounds and leading nett aggregate outwith the main prize winners.
5. The qualifying rounds will be held on Monday 1st and Tuesday 2nd August. The match play rounds will be held on Wednesday 3rd – Friday 5th August.
6. There will be a supplementary competition held Wednesday 3rd August – Friday 5th August for entrants no longer competing in the main tournament. The format will be two 18 hole handicap stableford competitions on Wednesday 3rd and Thursday 4th August. The leading four aggregate scores will contest knockout match play on Friday 5th August.
7. A limited number of free practice rounds will be available from 15.00 on Sunday 31st July. Please book in advance.
8. Entry will be open to amateur male golfers with a handicap recognised by the authority controlling golf in the country from which they enter (for the UK & Ireland this is CONGU). The maximum permitted handicap in the competition will be 28.
9. Entry fee will be £85 (members £45). Juniors who hold a recognised handicap may pay half the entry fee but will only be entitled to half the prize voucher. Under no circumstances will juniors be permitted to accept alcohol as part of their prize. They will be given a suitable, equivalent value, alternative.
10. Entries will only be accepted on this entry form accompanied by the relevant entry fee and a handicap certificate.
11. If a current handicap certificate is not produced on the 1st August, handicap adjustments after the qualifying rounds will be made from the lowest exact handicap for a given playing handicap. (e.g. A playing handicap of 11 will be adjusted from 10.5 in the absence of a current handicap certificate).
